Determine the Transmission Vector Explanation:

Each set of clues begins at the number on the cube and then travels either down or to the right.

Each clue set makes a complete loop around the cube.

The answers to the clues overlap each other by 2 letters. For example geoloGY GYmanST STead.

Once the clues are solved for the and entered into the cube there will be 8 letters that match where the lines meet up on the sides of the cube.

These eight letters spell out either songbird or bird song. Either answer is acceptable and they both work with the meta puzzle.
