## P1: Collecting Ingredients Part 2

Put in ADDITIONAL INGREDIENT (answer from part 1) across the top to get the letters for a few of the numbers.

Cryptic Clues (Cryptic portion bolded, normal clue underlined, hidden word in red):
Make coins in titanium interfaces: MINT
Calypso dance has pop: SODA
Darling, is part of each one yours: HONEY
Philippe, a charmer, embraces a sweet girl: PEACH
Herb is among wealthy merchants: THYME
Which ibis customarily holds a tropical flower: HIBISCUS
Olav, end erosion involving an ornamental plant: LAVENDER
Lindgren, a diner carries red syrup: GRENADINE
Now a term, "elongated," covers large fruit: WATERMELON
Filling in all the numbered cups with their corresponding letters found above, we get

This is a $9 \times 9$ grid with $3 \times 3$ blocks shaded slightly differently. This is supposed to imply a SUDOKU using the letters $N, I, A, D, T, C, O, E, H$ instead of using the numbers 1-9. Filling in the grid using SUDOKU rules, we end up with

Taking the red cups which go down the middle of a diagonal, we see the answer: ICE.
