We felt **higher than princes!**

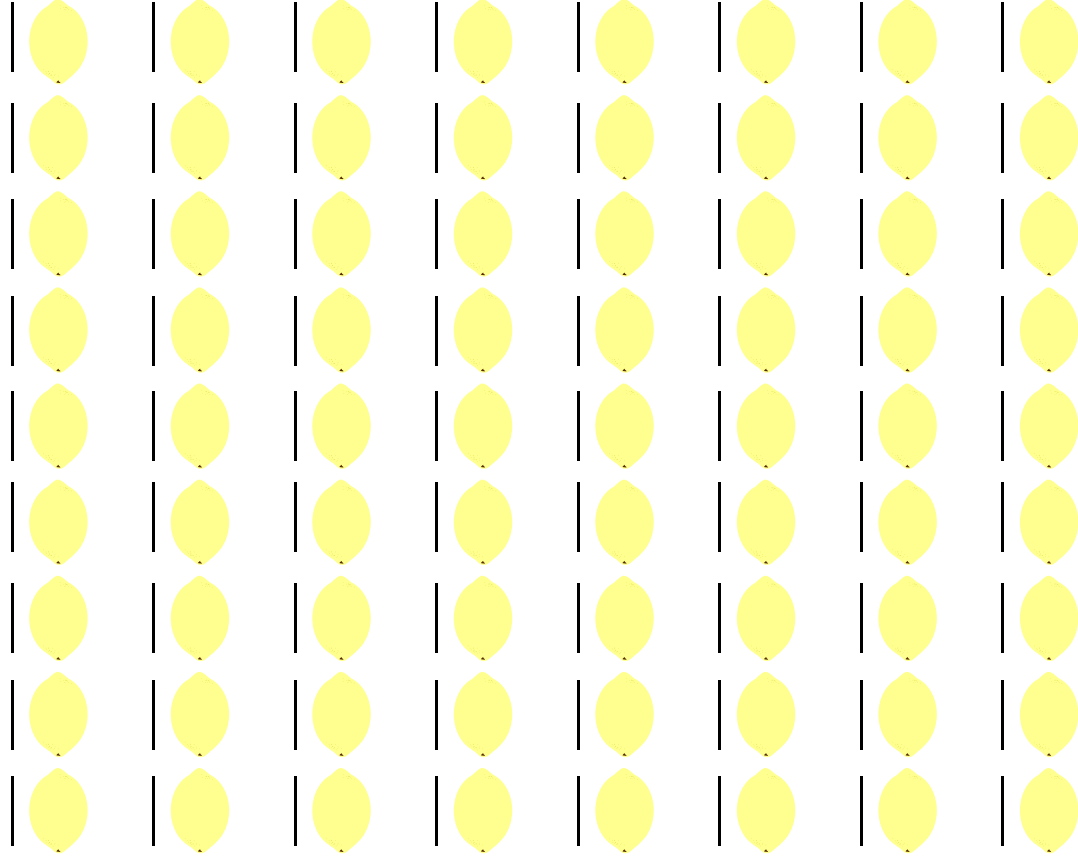
But with good fortune can come **unintended consequences**.
