

All of the crossword answers contain the word 'Keep' or 'Beat' within them. In the word search, these are represented by the brooms. All of the phrases are highlighted in word search on the next page in yellow.



As the flavor text hints, you can find paths for the chasers (highlighted in red) starting from each broom stick to the letters in 'FLY'. The three paths should read: •BANK WHO MERGED WITH JP MORGAN AND IS THE MERGED NAME'S SECOND HALF •DRINK A MILDER BEVERAGE AFTER CONSUMING ALCOHOL •NATIONAL LAMPOON ACTOR WITH FIRST NAME CHEVY The answer to all three of these is CHASE.

Finally, the seeker must find all remaining letters that have not been used. The remaining letters (highlighted in blue), read from left to right, top down read "THE SOLUTION IS **SWEEPSTAKES**."
