First we must arrange the puzzle squares into the grid forming compound words between each adjacent set of edges. The solution to this should look like the following:

Notice that in each square, there's a letter. That letter is the only letter shared by all four words in the square. Having created the grid, read from the center in a clockwise outward spiral to get the phrase:

LOOK FOR TEN CONFUSED ANIMALS

Flipping the board/squares over should yield the following sets of letters. Each row and column should unscramble to an animal as shown below in red.

Taking the indices shown on the sides into each of the corresponding words yields the answer: **HORSESHOES**
