



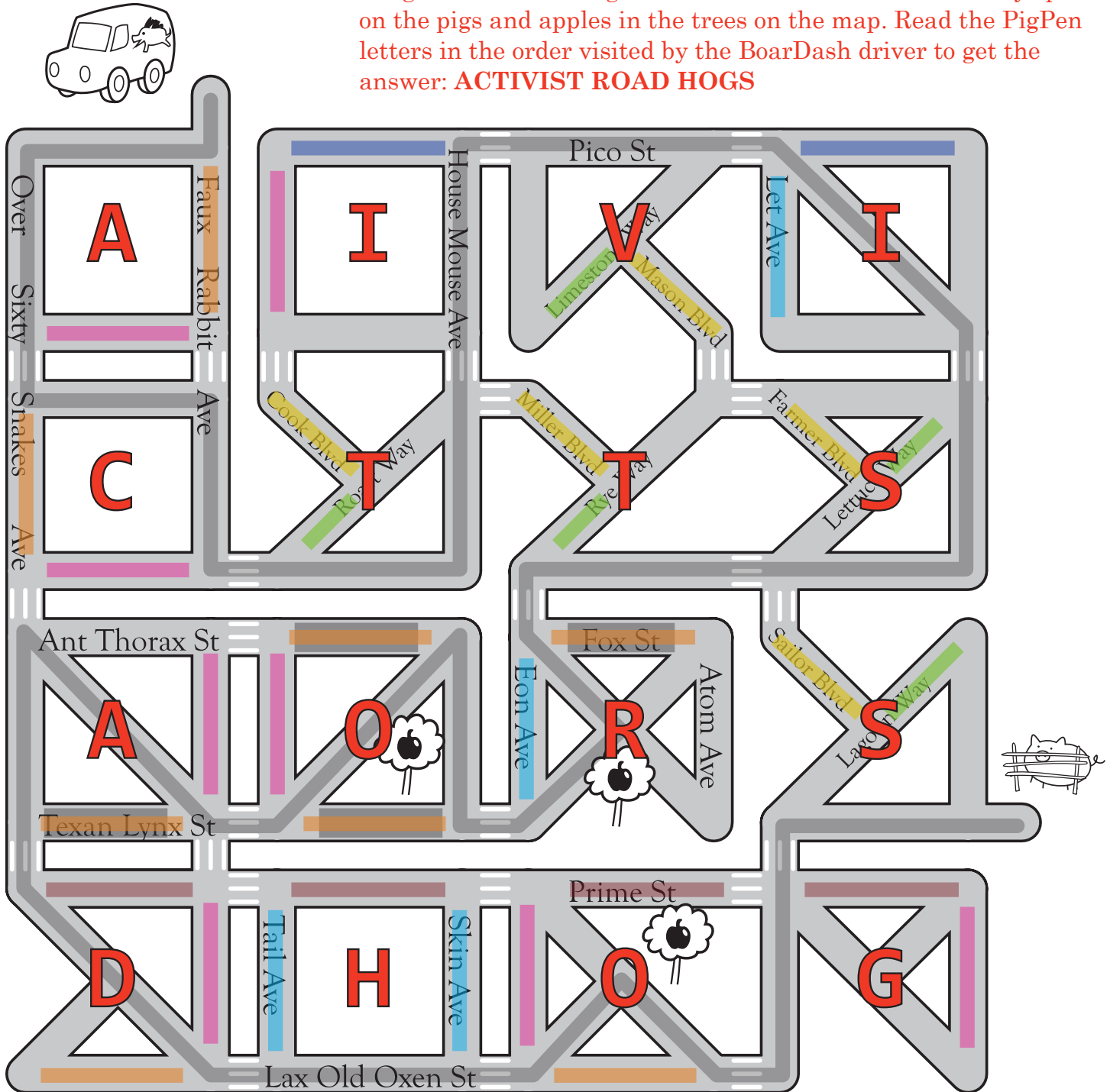

## TRAFFIC HAM

The sections of roads blocked off by the protesters form the edges of PigPen letters, one per block. Use the Petting Zoo page from the guidebook for a PigPen reference. Dots are indicated by spots on the pigs and apples in the trees on the map. Read the PigPen letters in the order visited by the BoarDash driver to get the answer: **ACTIVIST ROAD HOGS**



- Critter roads: Look at the words that make up its name (sans the road designation). For each word that contains an X, place a protester on the corresponding section of road. [8 orange highlights]
- Longest road: Prime St. [4 brown highlights]
- Boulevards: For every Boulevard, determine if the Way it intersects with starts with an L or an R. Turn left from the Boulevard if it starts with an L, otherwise turn right. [5 yellow and 5 green highlights]
- Atom, Eon, Let, Skin, Tail: You can add the word PIG before EON, LET, SKIN, and TAIL to create a new word, so ATOM is the odd road out! [4 blue highlights]
- Pico [2 purple highlights]; Buddies: [8 pink highlights]
