Solve initial steps for each grid, then use that information to determine how the grids pair up. After pairing, the combined clues will provide constraints for a unique solution. Use the Park Fees page in the guidebook to get a letter from the grid for each pair. Read those letters in order according to the table on page 1 to get: COVER-UP

- Futoshiki can't pair with Skyscrapers: They have different values for row 2, column 1.
- Futoshiki can't pair with Calcudoku: Calcudoku will have a 1 in one of the last two cells in the top row, but Futoshiki requires that both of those cells are greater than the cells below.
- Therefore, Futoshiki must pair with Sudoku.
