


The Great Pyramid of Giza

You have arrived at the Great Pyramid of Giza. The pyramid is divided into hexes, each of which can be filled in with a 6-letter word. After doing so, each tier will read clockwise around a level of the pyramid, from top to bottom, starting somewhere in the tier. However, it seems the translation of the tiers was not finished causing some sections to conflict with the hexes. Examining these shaded conflicts will tell you what to do next.
